



79th U.S. Women's Open Championship USGA Qualifying May 13, 2023

QUALIFYING MEMORANDUM TO PLAYERS

FORMAT/QUALIFYING PLACES: Stroke play competition conducted over 36 holes. The field of contestants will compete for 3 qualifying places and two alternate positions in the 79th U.S. Women's Open Championship to be played May 30 – June 2, 2024, at Lancaster Country Club in Lancaster, Pennsylvania. In the event of severe weather, call the Pro Shop or consult <u>www.njsga.org</u>. <u>The official</u> <u>rain date is Tuesday, May 14</u>.

REGISTRATION: Players are requested to check in upon arrival at the course. The registration area will be located near the Pro Shop. Players are to report to their assigned starting tees, ready to play, 10 minutes before their starting times.

STARTING TIMES: Starting times are posted here: <u>https://www.njsga.org/tee-times-information</u>.

PLAYOFF: In the event of a tie for the last qualifying places or alternates, there will be a hole-by-hole playoff to determine the final qualifiers and the 1st and 2nd alternate if necessary. All announcements regarding the play-off will be made at the public scoreboard upon completion of the qualifying round.

FOOTWEAR: Rule 4.3 is modified in this way: During a round, a player must not wear shoes with traditionally-designed spikes (regardless of composition, i.e., ceramic, plastic, etc.) or spikes, of any design, comprised either entirely or partially of metal (if such metal may come in contact with the course). Penalty for breach of this Local Rule: See Rule 4.3.

DRIVERS/GOLF BALLS: The Local Rule for Conforming Driver Heads is in effect, See Model Local Rule G-1. The Local Rule requiring that all golf balls used be on the List of Conforming Golf Balls is in effect. See Model Local Rule G-3. Please check the USGA website, www.usga.org, for a list of approved golf balls and drivers. The "One Ball Rule" is NOT in effect at qualifying.

GROOVES: The players clubs <u>must conform</u> to the grooves and punch mark specifications in The Rules of Golf that are effective from January 1, 2010. See Model Local Rule G-2. <u>The exception for Ping Eye2</u> <u>Irons manufactured before March 31, 1990 is not in effect.</u>

DMDS: The use of distance-measuring devices (DMD) is **PERMITTED** in qualifying, however not in the Championship proper of all USGA open championships. For more information, visit <u>www.usga.org/dmd</u>.

PACE OF PLAY: It is a condition that player must play without undue delay and in accordance with guidelines established by committee. Guidelines will be distributed upon arrival at the course. Pace of Play will be monitored and enforced via the "Checkpoint System" (refer to attachment).

EVACUATION PLAN: In the event of a discontinuance of play during the qualifier, players must adhere to the evacuation plan designated by the Committee.

PRACTICE ROUND AVAILABILITY: The club has graciously agreed to allow players the ability to play one (1) practice. Practice round dates are as follows: **Thursday, May 2**nd **after 1pm, Tuesday, May 7**th **after 1pm, or Thursday, May 9**th **after 1pm**. Players must contact <u>chip@haworthcountryclub.com</u> in advance to schedule their practice round. A mandatory \$50 cart fee (payable in the golf shop) would apply



to all practice rounds. The practice facilities will be open to players on the date of their practice round for a brief warmup session. **Pull carts are permitted**. Appropriate conduct is required. NO guests allowed.

The approximate yardages from which the qualifier will be conducted are listed below; these will be available for players in the Golf Shop.

PRACTICE FACILITIES/RANGE BALLS: Practice facilities are available only on a player's scheduled practice round day for a brief (30 minutes or less) warmup period. On the day of the qualifier, the practice facilities will be available to players for the duration of the day.

CADDIES: A player is not required to employ a caddie, but may bring her own caddie, or carry her own bag. Players and caddies must walk at all times during a round. Club caddies are not available.

CARTS: <u>Motorized transportation is prohibited in this competition</u>. Players must not ride on any form of transportation during a round unless authorized by the Committee. **Pull/Push carts are PERMITTED in this qualifier**.

GOLF SHOP/LOCKER ROOM/PRACTICE AREAS: The Clubhouse, Practice Range, and Pro Shop will open at 6:15 AM.

CODE OF CONDUCT: As set forth in the USGA application, the code of conduct applies to all USGA Qualifying and Championships.

PERSONAL APPEARANCE: Contestants and caddies must be neat in appearance. <u>The following applies to players, caddies, and spectators:</u> Proper attire is required at all times when on Club property. Women may wear pants, slacks, Bermuda-length shorts, skirts, and culottes (no more than three inches above the knee), and appropriate shirts. Men must wear collared dress or golf shirt. Shirts must be tucked in at all times. Golf attire is permitted in the clubhouse.

CELL PHONE POLICY: Cell phones are permitted, but please be courteous and responsible when using them (i.e. avoid disturbing those around you when on your phone). Player's cooperation with mobile "live scoring" is appreciated and more information will be provided by the starters.

FOOD SERVICE: A light breakfast for players only will be available at 6:30 a.m. Snacks, lunch, and beverages will also be available throughout the day in the clubhouse grillroom on a <u>cash / credit basis</u>. Please keep in mind that there will be a credit card processing fee added to all purches.

SPECTATORS: Spectators are welcome during the qualifier, however, no spectators are allowed to use carts and they must adhere to the dress code.
